Micropub. Up to 9 real ales, 1 real cider. Beers mainly sourced from smaller north-western breweries.



New dog-friendly town centre bar (Feb 2023) with a traditional, yet cosy feel. Up to three ever-changing cask ales on handpump. Live music.



Ben's Brewery Taproom. 6 real ales including their own range and a guest. Real ciders.



Micropub in market stall with separate lounge. 3 real ales, 2 ciders. Beers sourced from micro-breweries nationwide.



Irish Bar, 2 real ales sourced from north-western micro-breweries. Good banter.



Lively traditional town pub. Up to 4 real ales. Sports TV.



Modernised town centre pub. 5 real ales, 1 real cider. Live music.



9 real ales, mainly from Lancashire & Yorkshire breweries. Bar snacks. Live music (Sun). Beer garden.



Traditional award-winning pub 15-min walk out of town. Four cask ales served, invariably from local breweries. Pizzas available Wed-Sun.



Quirky and cosy café bar with rooms on 3 levels. 2 real ales.



Lively traditional town pub with up to 3 real ales. Beer garden. Sports TV.



Back street multi-roomed local. 3 real ales. Pub games (pool & darts).



Busy pub with up to 2 real ales, and still ciders. Food. Sports TV.



Traditional multi-roomed pub half a mile out of town, serving up to 6 cask ales from the Marston's range. Pool & Darts. Live music.



5 real ales (Marstons). Pub games (pool & darts). Beer garden. Sports TV. Live music (Sat).



2 real ales. Range of craft beers on 10 keg lines. Fine wines.



Smart town pub with 4 real ales. Sports TV. Live music. Function room and beer garden. Pub games (pool).



Café bar/micropub. 3 real ales sourced from local breweries. Live music.



Taproom and multi-area lounge. 9 real ales, 2 real ciders.



Wetherspoons on 2 floors. Up to 10 real ales. Food.



Comfortable multi-roomed pub with up to 3 real ales. Sports TV. Pub games (pool & darts).



4 real ales sourced locally. Pub games (pool & darts). Beer Garden. Sports TV. Food.
